From data on the Lincoln Regiments and local militia ONLY:

About 120 men lost their lives; about one half of these were from "Niagara-on-the-Lake".

About one half of those killed, died or wounded had wife/widow & minor children.

About 2/3rds of those taken prisoner were interned at Pittsfield, MA, USA.

About 1/3rd of those taken prisoner were from "Niagara-on-the-Lake" admin area.
