British regulars stationed at Fort George on May 27, 1813

The names of the British regulars stationed at Fort George on May 27, 1813 have been ascertained from the muster rolls of the respective regiments present that day. The word "stationed" has been used as it is not known, who was actually involved in the battle that took place on the 27th, other than those killed, wounded or taken prisoner. There were many who did not see any action on the front that extended from Queenston on the Niagara River to 4 Mile Creek on the shores of Lake Ontario.

There were 8 companies of the 49th Regiment at Fort George, Companies 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 8 and 9. Company 6 was based at Fort Erie and Company 10 was based at Chippawa. There were 7 men from Company 6 and 27 men from Company 10 at Fort George at the May 24th muster and so considered to be there on May 27th. There were 5 companies of the 8th (the King's) Regiment at Fort George, Companies 4, 5, 6, 7 and 9. There were 5 men from other companies of the 8th at Fort George on May 27th. They were Armourer as Sgt David Bligh, Company 1, (killed), Sgt William Vincent, Company 8, (POW), Sgt Nicholas Hayes, Company 10, (POW), Drummer/Fifer William Chandler, Company 3, (POW) and Private William Kerwin, Company 3, (POW). The Glengarry Light Infantry had 3 companies present, Companies 1, 5 and 9. The Royal Newfoundland Regiment had Companies 5 and 9. The Royal Artillery, 4th Battalion, had at least 49 men at Fort George, including Corporal John Gibb, who was at Amherstburg May 2nd muster, but at Burlington Heights June 1st muster, and may have taken some men from the 21 at Fort Erie and 3 at Chippawa. The Royal Artillery had musters at the beginning of each month and Gunner George White, who was based at Fort Erie at the May 2nd muster, was taken prisoner on May 27 at Fort George. As the Royal Artillery was short-manned, volunteer gunners were recruited from the 41st Regiment, of which around 450 were stationed at Fort Erie. The total number of volunteers is not known, but it is known that 15 of them were taken prisoner at Fort George. In addition, Sgt. Edward Atwood of the 41st, probably on the HQ staff, was made a POW. The names of these 16 men have been included on the Fort George roster for May 27.

In determining the names of the men, who were at Fort George on May 27, 1813, the muster rolls for the 49th Regiment and the 8th Regiment indicate that 27 men of the 49th and 53 men of the 8th had "joined from England on board the Lord Cathcart" and all were placed on the respective payrolls, effective May 15, 1813. The assumption, therefore, is that they were present at Fort George on May 15, 1813 and, thus, there on May 27. However, it could be that May 15 was a mandatory date, that these regiments had to accept these men on their payrolls, even if they were still in transit from England. To support this view, there is a section at the end of the March – June, 1813 muster rolls, which is entitled "Statement of rations supplied to officers while on board ship and who have joined at the Head Quarters of the Battalion during the period of this account". The date of "joining" is not recorded, but it must have been by the time of the third muster on June 24, 1813. The

statement does show that the name of the ship was the Lord Cathcart and the officers embarked at Cowes, Isle of Wight, on March15, 1813 and disembarked at Quebec on May 25, 1813 i.e. 71 days. Assuming the recruits for the 49th and 8th disembarked on the same date, there was no way they could have been at Fort George on May 27, let alone May 15. While the names of the men arriving from the Lord Cathcart have been included in the May 27 listing, they are clearly indicated as not being at Fort George on that date with an asterisk *.

Similarly, those men of the 49th who were at Fort Erie ** and at Chippawa *** on May 24 muster are included in the May 27 listing, but specifically noted by the asterisks as not being at Fort George. There is one exception, Corporal James Efford of Company 10 was recorded as being at Chippawa at the May 24 muster, but he was at Fort George on May 27, where he was "killed in action".

The names excluded from the Fort George May 27 listing relate solely to the men who were clearly stated to be elsewhere, other than the Niagara region, such as "Recruiting in England", "On Command at Kingston", "At York", etc. at the May 24, 1813 muster.

Private Thomas Boyce of the 49th, Company 8, was a POW on Parole at York July 24 and August 24 musters. He was at York February 24, March 24 and April 24 musters and probably captured at York when the US forces attacked on April 27. Private Thomas Porter of the 49th, Company 2, was at York April 24 muster and at Kingston June 24 muster. He was most likely at York on April 27, and would have retreated with Sheaffe to Kingston and remained there. Private George Mills of the Royal Newfoundland Regiment, Company 9, and Private Joseph Totten of the 8th Regiment, Company 5, were stated to be POWs on May 29. The location of their capture is not given in the muster rolls, but it is doubtful that it was during the retreat from Fort George. It is more likely that they were made prisoner at the attack on Sackett's Harbour that day, which has been confirmed, in the case of Mills, by the Casualty Returns. Privates Boyce, Porter, Mills and Totten have been included in the listing, but it has been concluded that they were not at Fort George on May 27, as signified by the asterisks ****.

The men shown to be at Fort George on May 27, 1813 are those engaged in the defence of Fort George, totalling 1367, plus 15 of the 49th sick in the hospital, who are marked separately, with asterisks *****.

MEN OF BRITISH REGIMENTS STATIONED AT FORT GEORGE MAY 27, 1813

The grand total of 1367 listed hereunder relates to the men of the British regiments, who were present and fit for duty at Fort George on May 27, 1813.

- A) In determining this figure, men, who clearly could not have been at Fort George according to the muster rolls, have been excluded from the numbers.
- B) Men, who joined from England on board the Lord Cathcart, 27 for the 49th and 53 for the 8th, and were on the payroll, effective May 15, 1813, were included, but it has been concluded they could not possibly have been at Fort George on the 27th, so they have been treated as being 'in transit' and designated "ABSENT".
- C) The 49th had 51 men of Company 6 plus a Sergeant Major and one Private from Company 1 and one Private from Company 10 based at Fort Erie and had 35 men of Company 10 plus one Sergeant from Company 2 and two Privates from Company 9 at Chippawa, at the May 24th muster and, thus, not at Fort George on May 27th. One Private of Company 2 was at York at April 24th muster and at Kingston at June 24th muster. Probably, he was at York, when US forces attacked on April 27th, and retreated with Sheaffe to Kingston and remained there. Another Private of Company 8 was a POW on Parole at July 24th muster. He had been at York for the three musters ending April 24th and likely at York on the 27th. All have been included, but considered "ABSENT".
- D) The Royal Newfoundland Regiment had one man in Company 9 and the 8th Regiment had one man in Company 5, who were made POWs on May 29, 1813. It seems probable that they were made prisoner that day at the attack on Sackett's Harbour, which in the case of the RNR man has been confirmed by the Casualty Returns. They have been included, but noted as "ABSENT".
- E) The 49th had 15 men sick in the hospital at Fort George and these men were deducted to arrive at the number of 1367, who were stationed at Fort George and ready for action.
