The Archaeology of the Redan Battery & the Battle of Queenston Heights: Online Presentation

October 15, 2021 at 10:00 am

The Battle of Queenston Heights holds great significance in Canadian military lore. This major victory early in the War of 1812 cemented Niagara Loyalists' sympathy for the British cause and inspired many to stand against American invasion of Upper Canada. Major General Isaac Brock's demise, while leading a frontal attack to retake the Redan Battery, gave loyalists their exemplary hero. Throughout this engagement the Redan Battery played a pivotal role and would later become a stopping point for visitors to the battlefield. In 1975, Parks Canada Archaeologist, Elizabeth Snow excavated the site to record the structural layout for restoration of the gun emplacement. Review of her artifact collection in 2012, 200 years after the battle, yielded unanticipated evidence of that fateful day, October 13, 1812.
